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The facilities of Bayshore Gardens are for the use of the **residents** and their **guest**.

Section 3 Use of district facilities—Persons entitled to use the district facilities and property of the district shall be limited to residents within the district, their family members and guests, and such other persons and groups as the trustees may authorize from time to time. The property of the district shall consist of real or personal property and improvements now or hereafter acquired, erected, or purchased by the trustees for the district. For the purposes of this act, each parcel of property in said district is hereby declared to be uniformly and generally benefited by the provisions hereof. Charter 2002-365

Only residents of Bayshore Gardens may have an ID Card for the use the facilities.

Owner/Residents may obtain their Bayshore Gardens ID card by coming to the office with picture identification that contains their Bayshore Gardens address as proof of residency.

Renters/Residents may obtain their Bayshore Gardens ID card by coming to the office with picture ID as proof of residency in Bayshore Gardens. If the renter does not have documentation to prove his/her residency, the owner of the rental property may also execute authorization for the renter by completing form 1001F. Only one family and their guests registered at an address may have the use of the facilities as residents.

ID cards must be renewed annually. The cards expire on December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.
