# GARDEN CLUB ARTICLE FOR DECEMBER 2024

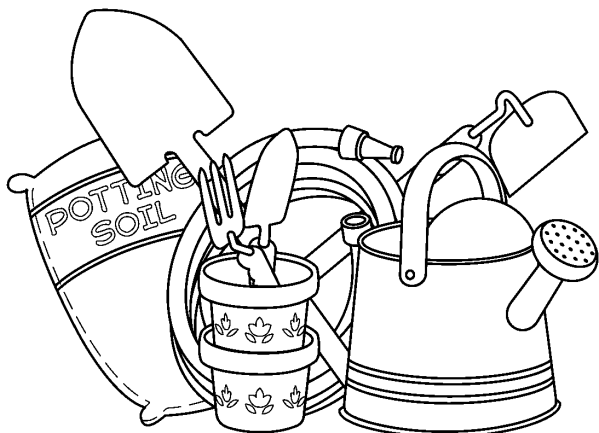

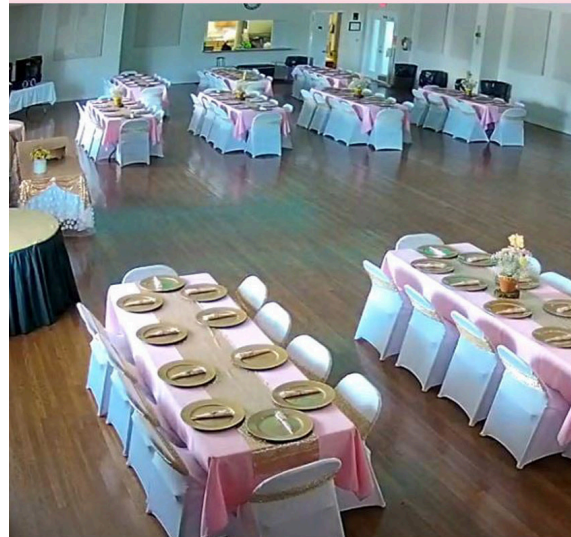
