

The following pages contain design ideas for replacing the functionality and space of the area in our park formally occupied by the large Ficus Tree. These are examples only and are not intended to be the exact style or design that will be built, should we choose to go with some type of event or gathering structure. Each group style corresponds with one of the answer options on the survey and any structure will be flanked by tropical/native plants.

Style 1: Mid-century – This will be something that attempts to match the classic mid-century style of the homes in our community and the existing smaller picnic pavilions in the park.



Style 2: Tiki or “Chikee” Hut – We would be interested in having such huts built by licensed Miccosukee tribal builders, who generally do not need full building permits and whose structures can withstand hurricane-force winds.
