

**Bayshore Gardens Park & Recreation District
Recreation Committee Minutes
July 18, 2019
District Recreation Hall**

The meeting was called to order by Chair Belle Baxter at 7:03

Attending were committee members Jim Frost, Kathi Frost, Joyce Fisher & Dan Rawlinson. Plus residents Allen Riga & Barbara Greenberg.

Picnic review – While turn out was light, everyone who attended had a good time. Music was a great addition. Sharon, Gwen & Sandy took in \$278.50 for food. Parking became a non-issue with help from Robert Hindle, Fergus Kelly & Dan Rawlinson.

Next year's picnic could be held in the picnic area. Jim Frost said that as long as there was a professional installing the inflatables he has no problem with them in that area. This would make it easier to travel from the inflatables/games, to food, to picnic tables, to the pool – no one would have to go across the parking field. Also we would be sure any liability is covered by our policy. Musicians and food would be in the screen room. There was discussion about the date for 2020 – the last Saturday in June vs. July 4. Belle will book the rec hall & screen room for both dates with the office and advise Gia to contact Belle when a request comes in for either room/date.

Other notes for next year – When setting up games keep them in an area so everyone has access; we set up behind the inflatables & ended up moving most of the games closer to the musicians. If, in the future, we want to rent inflatables there should be a bid to avoid any conflict of interest. Should have 2 people selling tickets for food. Two more game monitors would be helpful as would 2 more volunteers committed to help clean up.

Pool – Swim lessons – Laine has agreed to give swim lessons at the swim instructors rate. Anyone who is interested should sign up with her or at the office.

Back to School Swim Party – HOA will host the party but has asked Rec Committee for financial support for a DJ and any additional food/drinks that would be needed in addition to the picnic leftovers. Committee agreed to this.

Bayshore Dolphins will hold their banquet on August 2 in the Rec Hall. Jeanette will take care of the arrangements. Jeanette is also planning activities for the "winter" to maintain the cohesiveness of the team and encourage more kids to sign up.

Bayshore Marauders are celebrating fans on Saturday, August 24. A \$10 ticket gets Bayshore Gardens residents, families & friends a seat behind home plate & under cover, a free hat & drink and 5 raffle tickets for nice prizes. The group will also be invited onto the outfield grass to watch the fireworks. Committee agreed we can advertise this.

Zumba – Carol Dugan contacted us about teaching Zumba in the rec center, she has verbally agreed to our paid instructor policy and her usual charge is \$5.00 per student.. Committee agreed this is the kind of activity we are encouraging. Classes will be scheduled once the Rec Hall renovation is finished

Future plans include an adult pool party in September and a family picnic & movie night in the picnic area in October
