Agenda Items Discussed

Community Survey - The committee meeting was dedicated to a discussion regarding the final recommendations for the community survey.

- Per the Board discussion the survey will be delivered online only. No hardcopy surveys are to be used at this time, but we may need to go that route, should the online surveys not generate enough of a response. This decision was reached despite some lingering discussion from Sharon and Mary Lou regarding the equitable opportunity for all residents to complete an online-only survey.
- Dissemination of the final survey will be via email, as well as the promotion of a direct link and QR code to the survey. The committee also discussed the use of yard signs, the NextDoor App, and The Banner. The email link and QR code will additionally be sent to every household in Bayshore Gardens on the back page of the annual assessment notice.
- Skip volunteered to put together yard signs that had the link and QR code. Mary Lou mentioned she had several yard signs we could use and offered to drop them off at the office.
- The committee viewed the online draft copy of the survey and the interim responses on Skip's iPad, so they could see what everything looked like.
- The Committee discussed final revisions to the survey that included:
 - a) Removing the toddler/sprinkle area and changing it to children's splash park
 - b) The committee decided to add lights for the basketball and pickleball courts.
 - c) Add Kayak rental to the survey
- Before the Committee adjourned Sharon brought up the need to have all committee members (specifically her) approved by the Board chair. Skip stated that he would look into that requirement. Sharon also mentioned the fence on the east side of the pool that now cuts off access to the beach area. She stated the fence was easily defeated by her, so it most likely will not be effective against the individuals who we are trying to restrict access to. A discussion about the pedestrian gate access ensued and the Committee agreed there should be a fob-in and fob-out system.
