The car seat safety distribution classes are designed for families who are unable to obtain a car seat at the regular cost. Typically, qualifying families are to meet Medicaid guidelines or participate in some type of government assistance. Car seats can be distributed for unborn children or for children who are outgrowing their current seat.

The limit is one car seat per child, Unfortunately, we do not have the resources to distribute car seats for a second vehicle. The purpose of the program is that each child has the opportunity to ride safely in a car. We will provide education to transfer car seats from vehicle to vehicle.

Education and installation are a requirement to obtain a car seat for our program. Contributions of \$20 per convertible car seat are collected at the time of your appointment (cash or money orders only). Booster seats are \$10 each.
